3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

To work for the promotion of education, healthcare, social welfare, women and youth empowerment, and environmental protection; to support underprivileged communities through training, awareness, and assistance programs; to engage in animal welfare and tree conservation activities; and to provide relief and rehabilitation during natural calamities, emergencies, and pandemics, undertaking all lawful social development and welfare activities

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To promote education in all its forms including formal, non-formal, vocational, technical, skill-based, digital, and adult education, and to establish, support, manage, or assist schools, colleges, training centers, learning hubs, libraries, hostels, coaching centers, and e-learning platforms, especially for underprivileged and marginalized sections of society.
2. To provide healthcare and medical relief, including preventive, promotive, curative, rehabilitative, and palliative healthcare services, by establishing or supporting hospitals, clinics, diagnostic

centers, health camps, telemedicine services, mobile medical units, and awareness programs related to public health, nutrition, sanitation, hygiene, and disease prevention.

3. To undertake social welfare activities aimed at improving the quality of life of economically weaker sections, marginalized communities, senior citizens, persons with disabilities, destitute individuals, and vulnerable groups through welfare schemes, social assistance, rehabilitation, and livelihood support programs.

4. To promote women empowerment, gender equality, and women's rights by organizing training programs, skill development initiatives, self-employment projects, awareness campaigns, legal literacy programs, health and safety initiatives, and entrepreneurship development activities for women and girls.

5. To support youth development by conducting leadership programs, career guidance, personality development workshops, sports promotion, innovation labs, entrepreneurship mentoring, employment readiness training, and capacity-building initiatives for youth.

6. To engage in environmental protection and sustainability activities, including conservation of natural resources, climate change awareness, waste management, renewable energy promotion, biodiversity conservation, water conservation, and pollution control initiatives.

7. To undertake plantation, protection, and conservation of trees, forests, and green spaces, including afforestation, reforestation, urban forestry, nursery development, and public awareness programs for

environmental conservation.

8. To carry out animal welfare activities, including rescue, shelter, treatment, vaccination, sterilization, care, protection, rehabilitation, and awareness initiatives for animals, birds, and other living beings.

9. To provide relief, rehabilitation, and humanitarian assistance during natural calamities and emergencies such as floods, earthquakes, cyclones, droughts, fires, pandemics, or other disasters, including distribution of food, clothing, medicines, shelter, and essential supplies.

10. To conduct training and awareness programs on health, education, environment, sanitation, gender equality, social justice, digital literacy, financial literacy, and civic responsibilities for the benefit of society.

11. To undertake community development programs, including rural and urban development projects, slum improvement, infrastructure support, livelihood generation, and capacity-building of community institutions.

12. To support and promote education and welfare of children, including early childhood care, child protection, nutrition programs, prevention of child labour, child rights advocacy, and support for orphaned and vulnerable children.

13. To undertake research, documentation, surveys, and studies related to education, healthcare, social welfare, environment, and community development and to publish reports, manuals, and awareness material for public benefit.

14. To promote mental health and well-being, including counselling services, stress management programs, addiction prevention, suicide

prevention awareness, and psychological support services.

15. To support elderly care initiatives, including old age homes, healthcare assistance, social inclusion programs, and welfare schemes for senior citizens.

16. To accept grants, donations, contributions, subscriptions, CSR funds, etc., for furtherance of the Company's charitable objects.

17. To acquire, hold, manage, and dispose of movable and immovable properties solely for the attainment of the Company's charitable objects.

18. To undertake any other lawful charitable, social, or welfare activity that is incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects and aimed at the development, welfare, and betterment of society at large.

the doing of all such other lawful things as considered necessary for the furtherance of the above objects:

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

4 *The objects of the company extend to the

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

6 No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.

7 The liability of the members is limited.

Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

11 The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
